

CTRAC Kids Guidelines

There are a few guidelines we ask parents and kids to abide by for the sake of the other children and their families.

Please don't send your child to class if he or she exhibits one of the following:

1. A temp $\geq 100^{\circ}\text{F}$
2. Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
3. Eye/nose drainage
4. Respiratory symptoms
5. Rash
6. Lice
7. Pinkeye
8. Sore Throat / Severe Cough
9. Virus / Contagious Illness

Sometimes younger kids need a bathroom break in the middle of class. We will send a text message to the parents of children who need assistance. If a nursery-aged child becomes anxious or needs a diaper change, we will send a text message for an accompanying adult to assist.

We do not anticipate perfect behavior from children and will give grace in abundance; however, there are certain behaviors we ask to be avoided: hitting, biting, kicking, general aggression, profanity, bullying, threats, excessive talking, and disrespect towards others. If any of these behaviors are identified, the instructor will address the issue with a parent or accompanying adult after class or send a text message to the parent of the child to pick them up from class in order to join the parent for the remainder of the main service that week.

We will be implementing a new system for checking children in and out of classes each week. Each class will have a roster of children who regularly attend and space for writing in the names of children who are new. When children are dropped off and picked up in the Nursery, an adult will be expected to sign or initial the roster next to their child's name. When children enter the 4-6 and 7+ classes, the teacher will note their attendance by simply checking their name on the class roster. This system will help us ensure the safety of all children at all times.
